SITE RULES AND INFORMATION



Please familiarise yourselves with the following rules and information.

PARKING

There is no vehicle access to the Relay track/camping area, therefore you are asked to park in the allocated car park where you will be guided by stewards. Vehicles and their contents are left at the owners risk.

CAMPING

Camping can only take place in the middle of the track. Please be mindful of how much space you use. If you are taking up too much space at the detriment to others you may be asked to move your tents closer together.

BBQ's are not permitted at Relay this year.

Please take care of grass due to shot put indentations on the grass.

The closer to the stage you camp, the closer you will be to the speakers, which although are lowered overnight, can still be clearly heard.

All rubbish must be cleared and taken home with you. Bin bags will be provided on Sunday morning.

WEATHER

Please remember to use sunscreen (limited supplies are available at the Cancer Awareness Station in the Relay Hub), wear a hat, and loose clothing.

Please drink water to stay hydrated.

Take time out if you are feeling unwell and seek medical advice if you are concerned.

If it is not sunny and a little wetter than wished for, please take care when walking across the grassed areas as they may become slippery.

TOILETS AND CHANGING FACILITIES

Toilets and showers are available in the bar area of the clubhouse for the full 24 hours.

WATER AND ELECTRICITY

If you need water or electricity at any point please speak to a member of the YOSC or Relay team.

SMOKING

Relay is a non-smoking event. Please do not smoke on site, if leaving the site to smoke, please cover your Relay tee shirt.

SITE RULES AND INFORMATION CONT.

ALCOHOL

Alcohol will be on sale from the Clubhouse Bar during normal licensing hours. You are not allowed to drink alcohol on the track. Please take care with glass and do not walk with glasses on the track.



DOGS

No dogs except guide dogs are not allowed on site.

CHILDREN

Children must be supervised at all times and remain the responsibility of their parents/carers. The collection point for any lost children will be the stage. Please write your contact number on the back of the child wristband and ensure that they are wearing these at all times- these are available at the Relay Hub.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the event of a major emergency, an announcement will be made via the PA system which will detail what action needs to be taken. In the event of an evacuation of the YOSC sites, please note the following:-

1. The assembly point is in the main tarmacked car park.
2. Team captains are responsible for ensuring that all of their team members are accounted for at the assembly point.

FIRST AID

There is first aid provision on site for the duration of Relay. If you cannot make it to first aid as detailed in your event programme please alert a member of the YOSC or Relay team.

FUNDRAISING

If you have decided to fundraise during the event, you must ask people to 'donate' rather than 'pay'.

DEPARTURE

Teams are free to dismantle tents etc. at any point during Sunday morning, however, we kindly ask that there is no major movement of equipment from the site until after the end of Relay.
